All **Altar Servers** are welcome. Plan to vest for 8:00am Mass.

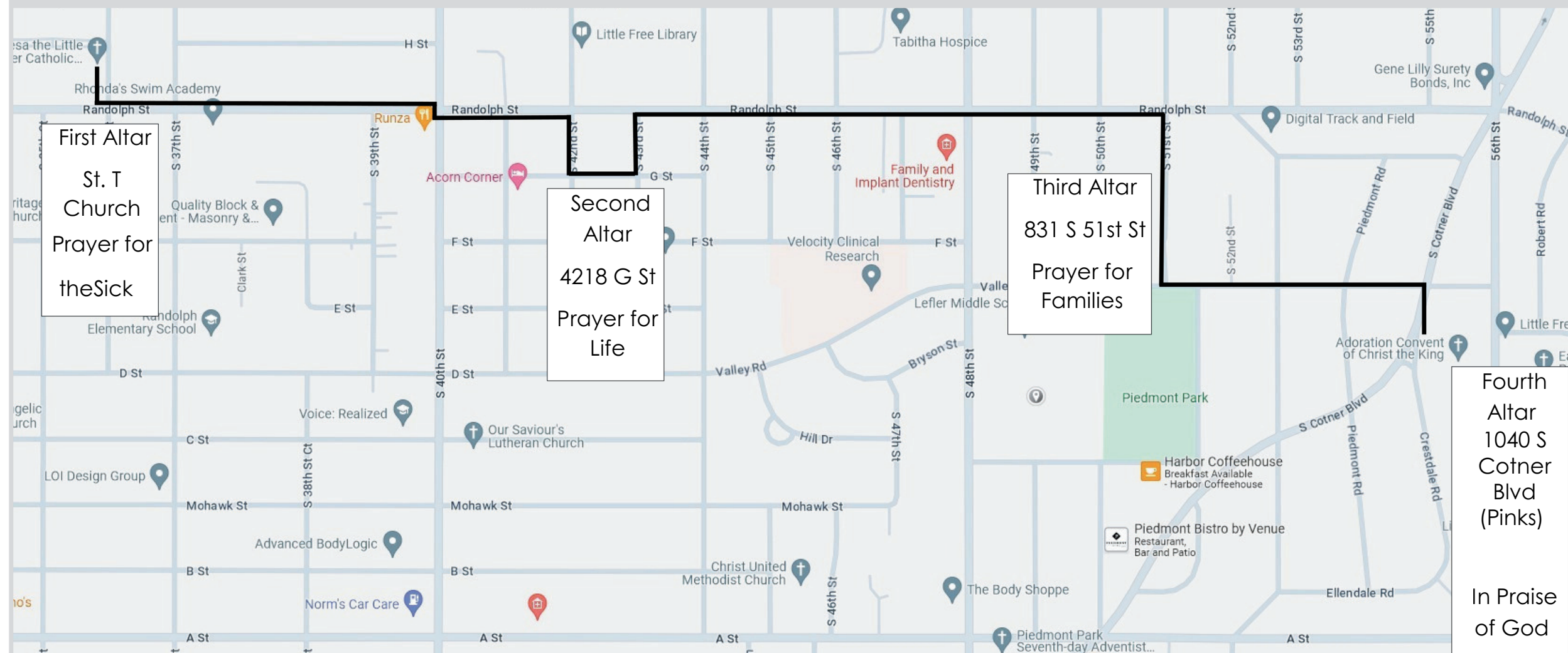
Children—especially **First Communicants**, who are encouraged to wear their sacrament-day-clothing—are welcome to **drop flower petals** toward the front of the procession. Before the closing song, those children should begin heading toward the corner of 36th & Randolph near the St. Teresa sculpture. There will be an adult leader to help them.

After Mass, everyone participating may simply **follow the procession**. If you are unable to walk the 1.6 mile route, you are welcome to join us for the hymn and benediction at the individual altars. The addresses are listed on the map.

Estimated time of arrival at the Pink Sisters' Chapel is 9:45. Donuts and bottled water will be available outdoors. The school bus will be available to bring people back to the church.
