Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

St. Teresa Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is hosting an adult retreat into the most essential elements of the Catholic faith. Designed to prepare adults to become catechists by immersing them in the CGS method, formation involves studying scripture and liturgy, understanding child development, and learning how to present religious concepts to children through specially designed materials and a dedicated environment known as the atrium. The formation invites participants to deepen their own faith while learning how to guide children's spiritual development. Level 1 formation honors the spiritual values of the 3 - 6 year old child. Part 1 will be May 29th-31st, 2025 and June 25th - June 28th, 2025. Part 2 will be 7 days in summer 2026. Tuition waived for those who volunteer.
