St. Teresa Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is hosting an adult retreat into the most essential elements of the Catholic faith. Designed to prepare adults to become catechists by immersing them in the CGS method, formation involves studying scripture and liturgy, understanding child development, and learning how to present religious concepts to children through specially designed materials and a dedicated environment known as the atrium.
